

Fall 2026 Class Descriptions

3D Print & Play: Board Game Design Lab \$20 Grades 3-8

Step into the role of a modern game designer! In this exciting class, students will use a guided design packet to invent their own gaming rules, sketch out a custom board, and design unique player pieces. Watch your creations come to life as your custom board and game pieces are 3D printed, ready for you to color, polish, and play with family and friends!

All Things Ponies & Horses \$5 Grades K-2

In this class kids will learn about ponies through educational books, horse and pony coloring books, and fun conversations to learn more!

Amazing Earth Explorers! \$15 PreK (ages 3-5)

In this class we will do fun hands on activities to help learn different concepts about our earth. Each week will be a new concept and if the weather permits we will get outside as well!

Beginner Crochet \$12 Grades 3-8

This beginner crochet class is a relaxed and friendly introduction to crochet for students from elementary through high school. Students will learn the basics like how to hold a hook and yarn, practice common stitches, and get comfortable with crochet terms at their own pace. The focus is on learning skills and having fun rather than finishing projects, so there's no pressure—just lots of hands-on practice and encouragement. No experience is needed, and students are welcome to explore, ask questions, and enjoy learning a new creative skill. All experience levels welcome.

Build a Business \$20 Grades 6-12

Have you ever dreamed of starting your own business? In this hands-on class, students will develop a business idea from the ground up while learning the basics of entrepreneurship. We'll explore branding, marketing, budgeting, customer service, and business planning. By the end of the semester, students will create and present their own business concept, complete with a logo, marketing materials, and a plan for success. Perfect for creative thinkers, future business owners, and anyone who loves turning ideas into reality.

Creative Writing/Storytelling \$5 Grades 3-5

Students will brainstorm and create their own storyline, then they will make their ideas come to life into their own book. Students will be given the opportunity to read their stories aloud on the last day of class, if they would like to.

Diamond Art \$5 Grades 6-8 and Grades 9-12

We will be working with various types of diamond art - Including solo projects and one big group project we all will contribute to.

Dollars & Sense: Teen Personal Finance \$10 Grades 6-12

This class provides students with a comprehensive introduction to personal finance. Together, we will look at how money works in the real world, covering everything from basic cash flow and budgeting to credit management and introductory investing. Our goal is to demystify personal finance so teens can build strong financial habits early in life.

Dolly & Me \$10 Grades K-2

Bring your favorite doll to this class where we will share new adventures each week!

Drawn to Design \$25 Grades 9-12

Fashion is more than clothing - it's wearable art. Through weekly drawing challenges and creative design projects, students will explore color, texture, patterns, and personal style while drawing inspiration from fashion throughout history. They'll create original fashion illustrations and discover how history can inspire modern design. No sewing experience required - just bring your creativity!

Energy Explorers \$18 Grades 3-8

This interactive class introduces children to the fascinating world of energy through experiments, building challenges, and teamwork. Kids will discover how energy is all around them and how it powers our everyday lives. Students will understand different forms of energy and how energy can change from one form to another.

Finger Painting Fun! \$10 Grades K-2

Test out a variety of painting styles/crafts as we get creative and a little messy ;)

For the Love of Books: From The Mixed-Up Files \$6 Grades 6-8

Dive into a good book with us! "From The Mixed-Up Files of Mrs Basil E. Frankweiler" is a classic tale of a brother and sister who run away to a museum and get caught up in a mystery while there... We will be reading aloud each week. The focus will simply be on getting "lost" in a book.

For the Love of Books: The Mysterious Benedict Society \$8 Grades 6-8

Get lost in this large but captivating story... "The Mysterious Benedict Society" is the first book in its series, and tells the winding tale of mystery, friendship, and hilarity. While it is truly in many ways an incredible commentary on society and media, our focus will simply be on getting "lost" in a book. It is a larger book than we have tried to accomplish here before, and will therefore require some reading at home during the week. If you've been looking for a book your child can't put down, this one has a real shot!

Fun with Math! \$5 Grades K-2

Come grow in your math skills with classic fun activities like Fast Math and Bizz Buzz. We will be covering addition and subtraction, as well as basic multiplication and division. If they are proficient at understanding a skill, then we will focus more on improving speed. Speedy repetition is key to future math skills!

Girls Gymnastics \$10 Grades 3-5

We will predominantly focus on flexibility and tumbling aspects of gymnastics. You must have either had experience in an official gymnastics class and/or participated in one of my previous Beginner Classes.

High School Game School \$5 Grades 9-12

We will be playing strategy games each week that teach things such as logic, multi-step planning, and long-term vs short-term planning. Students should come ready to challenge themselves while having a great time!

High School Jeopardy \$5 Grades 9-12

We will be playing Jeopardy using everything from Pop Culture to the Bible to educational content such as geography or history. Come planning to have fun and stretch your trivia brain!!

Highschool Cooking Class \$30 Grades 9-12

Teaching cooking skills covering terminology and using various techniques and ingredients to be comfortable cooking in the kitchen in the future

Jeopardy for Mini's \$8 Grades 3-8

Jeopardy for Minis is an 8-week game-based class for grades 3-8. Students answer Jeopardy-style questions in teams, building knowledge and quick thinking. Weeks 1-6: two groups compete weekly. Weeks 7-8: Tournament of Champions. Small prizes awarded to winners each week.

Jr High Media Production \$30 Grades 6-8

Those interested in media production will use professional equipment and editing software. The 'Media Production' class will educate an interested learner on the importance of visual editing. Jr High Music & Studio Production \$30 Grades 6-8

Those interested in music and studio production will use professional equipment and software. The 'Music & Studio Production' class will educate an interested learner on the how to run and operate a professional studio, use of sound equipment and upkeep. This will consist of the creation and production of different forms of music they are interested in eg: Jazz, Rock, Rap, Christian, EDM etc

Jr High Spelling Bee Academy \$15 Grades 6-8

Become a master speller!! Fun games & interactive projects will be integrated throughout the semester to prepare students for the final spelling bee challenge!! Who will be the champion master speller?

Junior Chefs \$20 Grades K-2

We will be having fun learning how to make 8 different types of cookies! I plan on asking my students their favorite type of cookie and we will go from there.

Junior Scientists Lab \$15 Grades K-2

Answering one big question each week, via testing hands on. Examples are what sticks to magnets, what floats in water, how light changes things, etc. Students will each get a small notebook to record what they learned (kept by teacher during semester, then taken home at the end of the class).

Just For Fun Gym Games \$5 Grades K-2

Get ready to move, laugh, and play! In this high-energy class, students will enjoy a variety of fun gym games that encourage teamwork, listening skills, coordination, and active play. From relay races to classic group games, every week is packed with movement and smiles.

Lego creative build \$12 Grades 3-8

Students are encouraged to use legos to build and create according to weekly themes.

Lego Lab \$30 Grades K-2

This is a hands-on creativity-fueled class! Be ready to build, design, and problem solve with Legos! Some Lego building experience prior to class is recommended.

Lego Robotics (part 1) \$28 Grades 3-8

We will use Legos, motors and sensors along with the Lego WeDo 2.0 programming software to make Lego creations come to life. Projects will offer a real world application and will challenge students to use creative problem solving skills to model reality and conduct experiments. Materials will be provided for the class.

Little Chefs Snack Lab \$30 PreK (ages 3-5)

Mix, measure, create, and taste! In this hands-on class, students will learn basic kitchen skills while preparing simple snacks and treats together. Each week, children will practice measuring, pouring, stirring, spreading, and assembling ingredients while exploring new flavors and foods. Through fun snack-making activities, students will build confidence, follow directions, strengthen fine motor skills, and learn about kitchen safety and teamwork. Recipes will be simple, age-appropriate, and designed for young learners. No prior cooking experience is needed—just a willingness to try something new and have fun!

Lower Elementary Silly Stories \$10 Grades K-2

Let's laugh and learn together! We will learn about elements of a story through some silly, funny literature!

Lower Intensity Gym \$10 Grades 3-8

General gym games and practicing a different sport each week. Tag, sharks and minnows, soccer, and dodgeball are some of the games we will play. If the weather is nice, we will go outside. Please dress for the weather and bring a water bottle.

Mini Clay Makers \$22 Grades 3-8

This fun, independent, student-directed craft class, allows kids to choose their own mini air dry clay kit each week (think cute animals to mini desserts to space themed pieces)! These pre-colored clay kits come with step-by-step picture guides, allowing students to work independently to sculpt a new pocket-sized masterpiece every session to take home that very same day.

Mini Makers Science Lab \$20 PreK (ages 3-5)

Get ready to mix, build, test, and discover! Young scientists will explore the wonders of science through exciting hands-on experiments including bubbles, magnets, slime, volcanoes, sink-or-float challenges, and more. This class encourages curiosity, creativity, and a love of learning through play and exploration.

Most competitive non competitive gym ever \$5 Grades 9-12

Will be instructing and playing all different sports from soccer, volleyball, ultimate frisbee, jam can, cornhole, bocci plus basic exercises to stretch first.

Nutrition \$20 Grades 9-12

Learn how food affects energy, mood, athletic performance, weight, and overall health. Students will explore the basics of nutrition, read food labels, evaluate popular diets, and develop practical skills for making informed food choices. This hands-on class includes activities, discussions, and real-world applications to help teens build healthy habits that last a lifetime.

Passport Pals: A Trip Around the World \$20 Grades 3-5

Pack your imagination and grab your passport! Each week, we'll visit a new country and discover its culture through stories, crafts, music, games, and tasty treats. Preschoolers will explore the world while learning about different people, traditions, animals, and landmarks in a fun, hands-on way.

Perler beads \$10 Grades K-8

Playdough & Crafts \$10 PreK-Grades 2

Through sharing, listening, and conversation, children will strengthen public speaking, social skills, and self-expression while having fun with friends. No prior experience is needed—just curiosity and a willingness to share!

Show and Tell (3rd-5th) \$8 Grades 3-5
